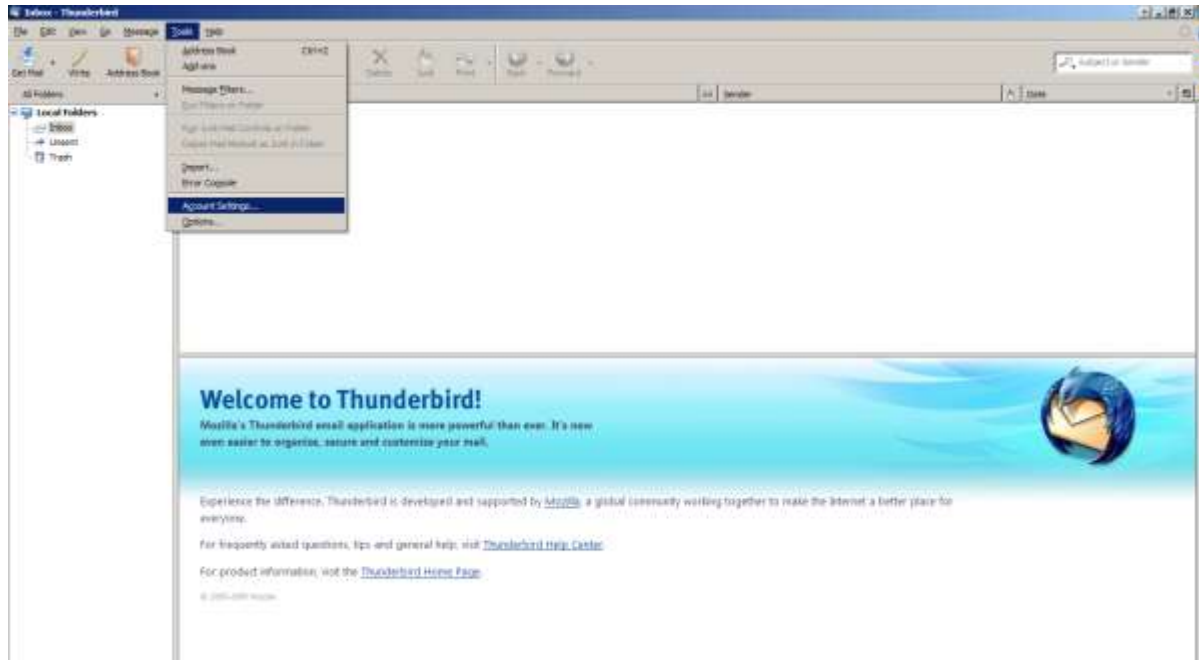
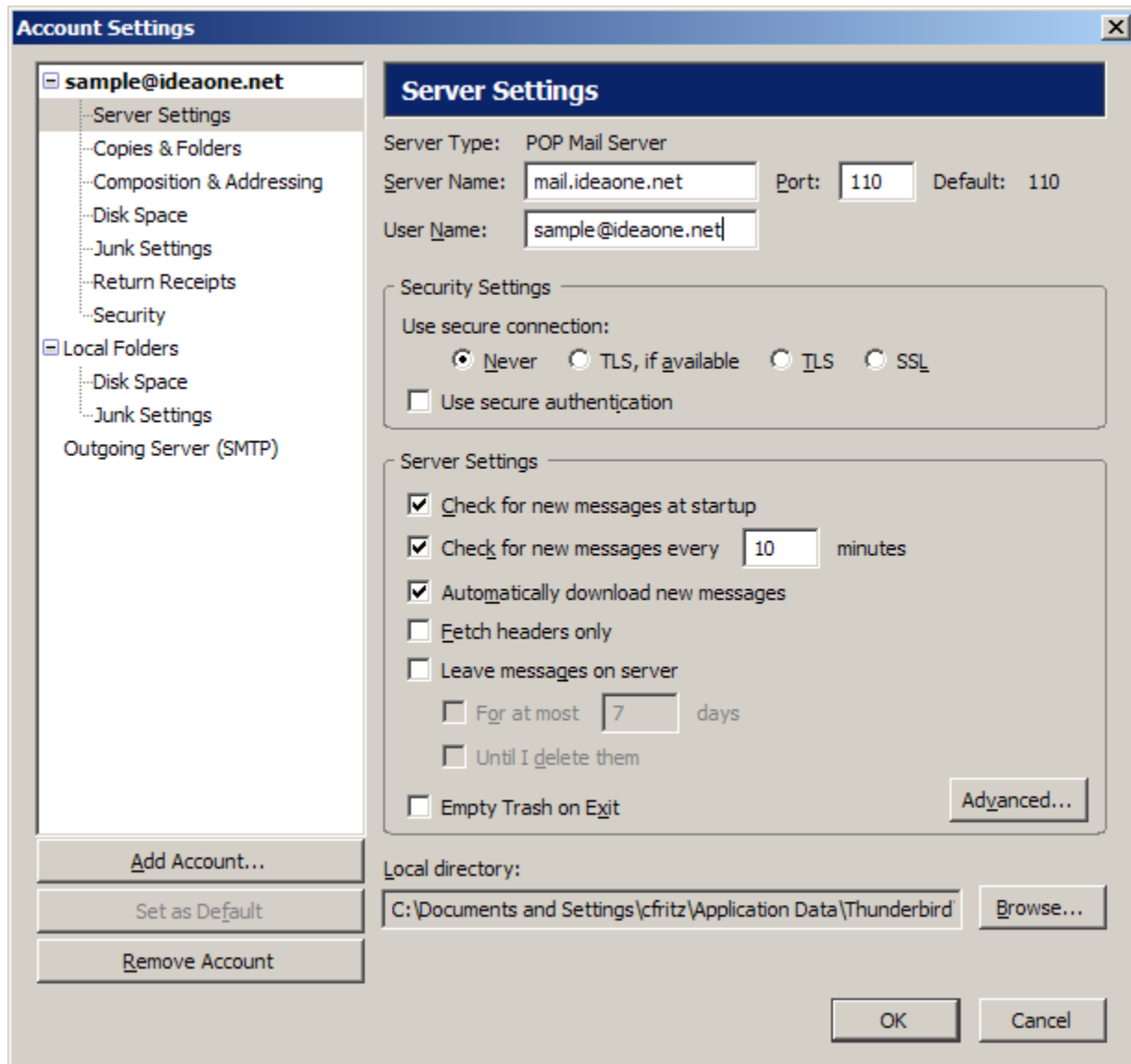


Mozilla Thunderbird – Change or Modify your settings

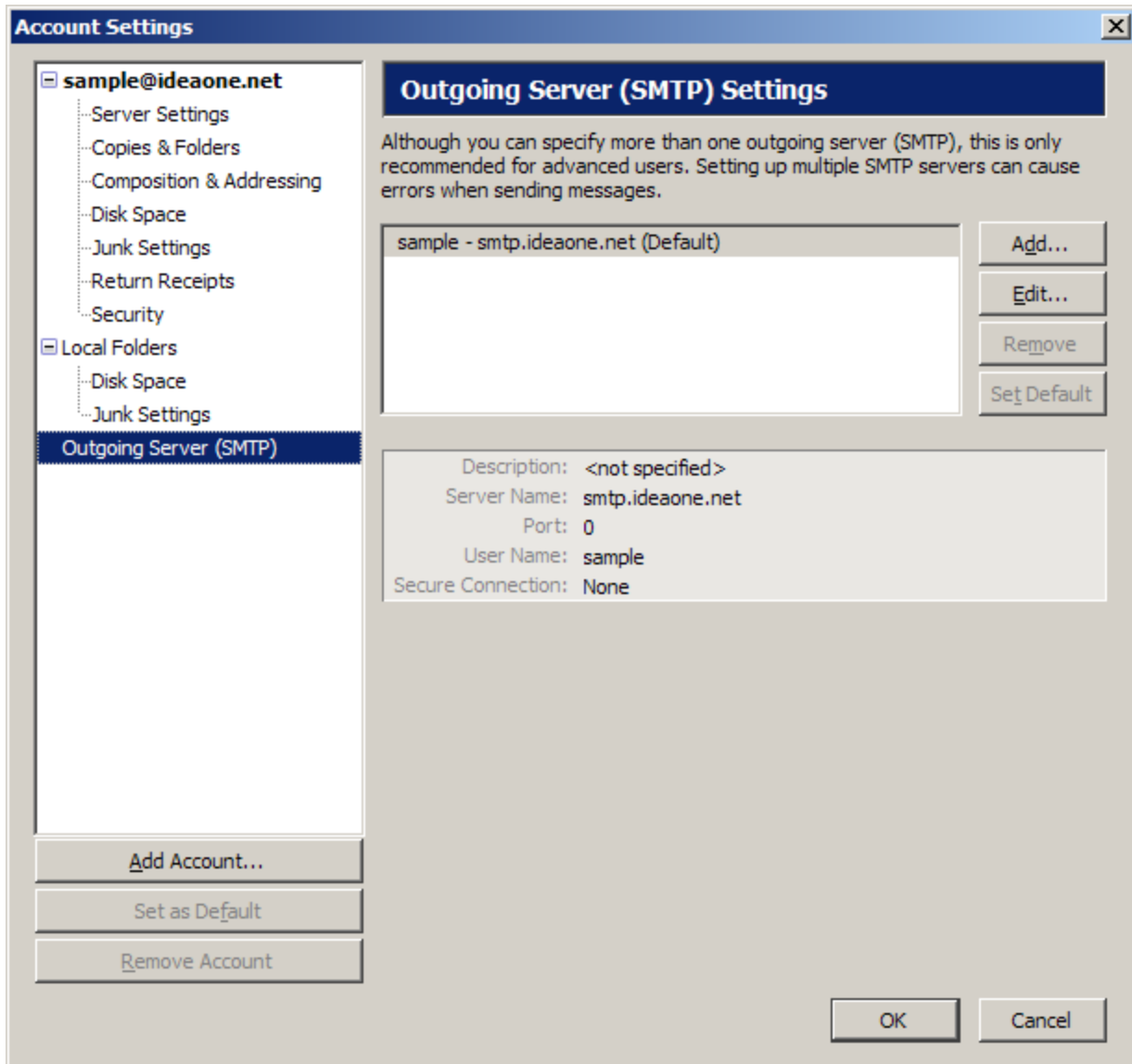
Open Mozilla Thunderbird and go to Tools -> Account Settings.



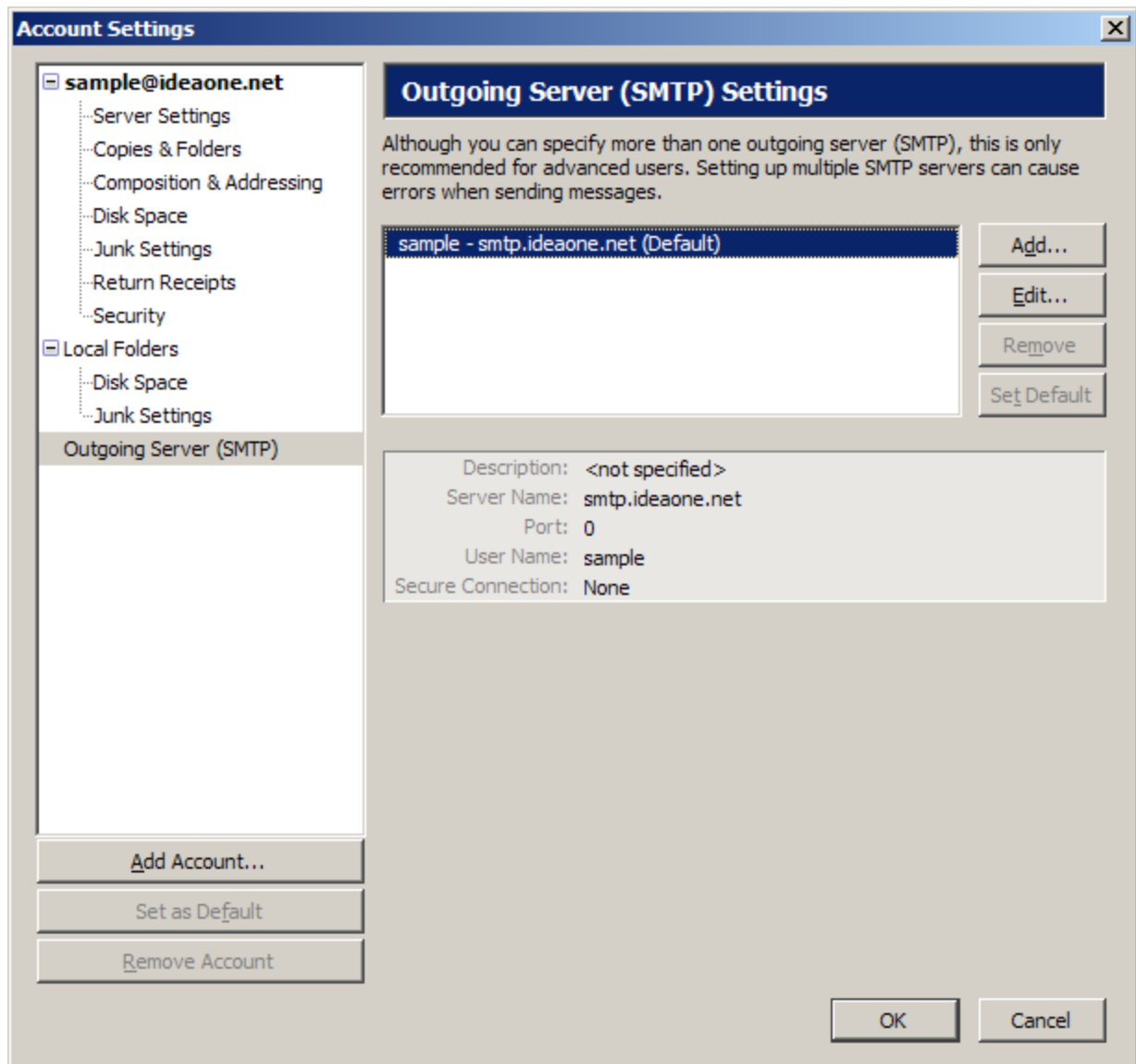
Select Server Settings. On the right change the "User Name: " to be your email address.



On the Left Select "Outgoing Server (SMTP)".



On the Right select the smtp.ideaone.net listed then Click "Edit..."



Security and Authentication should have "Use name and password" checked. The "User Name:" is your email address. Click OK.
